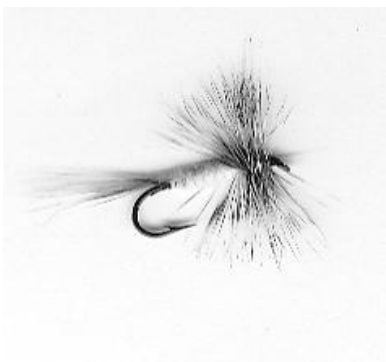


## Gray Hackle Yellow Wingless

**Fly type:** Attractor Dry

**Originator:** Unknown, Modified by Bob Souza

**Tied by:** Bob Souza



**Hook:** 5262-2x size 10-18 1x fine wire

**Tail:** Gray Grizzly Hackle barbs

**Ribbing:** optional Fire orange thread

**Body under wrap:** N/A

**Marking pen:** N/A

**Wing Case:** N/A

**Thorax:** N/A

**Body:** Pale Yellow or Bright Yellow Antron

**Legs:** N/A

**Wing:** optional

**Hackle:** Gray Grizzly Neck Hackle Grade #1

**Bead Head:** N/A

**Head:** Black tying thread.

**Optional:** High Gloss Head Cement.

Tying Instructions:

1. Select size of hook, install in vise and debarb.
2. Wrap a base of thread from one eye space to top of bend at tail area.
3. Select about one tooth pick of hackle barbs for tail and tie in on top of hook.
4. Dub antron onto thread and make a tapered body to  $\frac{1}{4}$  behind head space tie off dubbing.
5. Tie in one or two gray Hackle feathers wrap full hackle to head space and tie off.
6. Form small head with thread and whip finish.
7. Apply head cement if needed.

This fly is for use in fast broken riffle type of water as a searching pattern. Use this fly when there is no hatch going on. When in broken type of water use a short leader as all the casting will be under 20'.
