

Black and Peacock

Fly type: Attractor
Originator: Bob Souza
Tied by: Bob Souza



Hook: 200r 3x size 6-18
Thread: 6/0 black
Tail: Black Rabbit Hair strip
Rib: Optional copper wire
Body: Peacock Herl
Thorax hackle: Black Hair strip

1. Debarb hook and place in vise. Dress thread to hook shank from head space to hook barb.
2. Tie in rabbit hair tail length of body. Use zonker strip for this about ¼" piece.
3. Take copper wire rib and tie in at bottom of hook shank.
4. Tie in 4-8 pieces of peacock herl and form a herl rope around thread, wrap herl forward in a tapered body to thorax and tie off.
5. Take copper wire and wrap forward in four even wraps and tie off.
6. Form a dubbing loop, cut and insert about ½ "of rabbit hair in loop from zonker strip, hold to proper length and cut hide off, twist to form hair hackle. Comb back as you wrap hackle.
7. Whip finish head and finish with head cement.

Note: This fly can be tied in variations of color, olive /light gray/olive, white/peacock/olive, olive/dark gray/light olive, etc.

This fly has worked all over the area in all types of water. It's not a hard fly to tie. As I do not like to spend a lot of time at the tying bench this one is a favorite since I would **rather be fishing.**
