

Stillwater Leech, Bead Head

Fly type: Attractor

Originator: Bob Souza

Tied by: Bob Souza



Hook: 200r 3x size 6 -14

Head: Gold or black to size of hook

Tail: Marabou with flashabou mix

Body: Crystal flash dubbing black, orange and peacock mix

1. Install bead, debarb hook if needed.
2. Put clear nail polish on hook and wrap thread to hook barb.
3. Make tail length of body with flashabou mix in and tie off.
4. Make dubbing loop put dubbing in loop and twist loop. Wrap too eye and tie off.
5. Finish with whip finish for head.

This fly is my go-to fly for stillwaters. It's simple to tie and has worked for me over the last twenty years in foothill lakes for bass and trout. Fish it deep and slow.
